Trust is the foundation of our relationships be they human or with God. To have a relationship with God means we must trust that He loves us, guides us and will provide for us in our life's journey.



ONGOING FORMATION CORNER

SUMMATIVE EVALUATION MODELS

Project evaluation was the theme we discussed in the last issue of the ongoing formation corner. It was suggested that evaluation be made at different levels to render the project more productive: a *situational analysis* at the preparative level, an *intermediary/formative evaluation* at the actualisation level and a *summative evaluation* at the conclusion level. The first two may be relatively easier as they are essentially *fact-finding* exercises. Evaluation at the summative level instead, can be more difficult as it tries to evaluate and report the *performance level* of the project. Given the variability of its elements, evaluating a project of ongoing formation could be more difficult. A target-group oriented approach (according to age, year of ordination, special needs etc.) could render its performance measurable. To make it more concrete and practical this issue presents some models of summative evaluation of a project. They will essentially be characterised by principles of religious life and aspects of charismatic identity of Missionaries of Faith.

1. Content evaluation:

At this point I think it is apt to recall what was discussed in the 18th issue of M.F. NEWS regarding the content of a project of formation: **reality contents** (the reality of identity, belongingness, participation etc.), **existential contents** (realm of 'being' that influences one's becoming, growth and relations), **contents of values** (source of motivation, systems of truth and morality, virtue, culture, transcendence etc.), **instrumental contents** (the techniques, the capacities, the abilities etc.). The evaluation of the project must be in correspondence to its content.

There could be the descriptive model (which is in use in our Congregation) or the scale model of evaluation. The first is essentially a questionnaire regarding the performance level of the content, while the latter is more mathematical on an evaluation table. I shall provide a brief sketch of them to be used as per the discretion of the concerned formators

2. The descriptive evaluation model

Existential contents:

- ⇒ Describe briefly how the M.F. in ongoing formation has deepened his religious identity
- His concept of religious life
- Idea of the evangelical counsels
- Knowledge of the Congregation
- Image of the charismatic identity
- Devotion to our patrons
- Attitude towards community life

In this way, all the contents that were proposed in the formation project, designed to achieve certain characteristics, are to be described. Based on the progressive and positive outcome of this description, the person's progress is evaluated. I do not intend to prolong this commonly used evaluation model.


News from Holy Trinity English Medium School, Dharmajigudem

Vice-province of Italy

First Pastoral Visit of H. E. Msgr. Gerardo Antonazzo in the Pastoral Area of Cervaro

Bishop Antonazzo officially commenced his first pastoral visit on Sunday 17 January 2021, in St. Paul's parish, Cervaro, in the presence of all the priests of the Pastoral Area, the faithful, and the civil authorities. The parish priest, Fr. Ignacio Roderick, mf, together with the zonal Vicar, Don Remo Marandola, welcomed the Bishop with the ritual invitation of the Pastor who visits his people.

By knocking on the door of the parish church, the Bishop wanted to indicate that we must all open our hearts to the redemptive love of Jesus; with the kiss of the Crucifix and the sprinkling with holy water, he recalled the price paid by Jesus for us and the grace of Baptism.

On Wednesday 20 January, the Bishop first went to the Shrine of the "Madonna de Piternis" for a Marian prayer. On the same day he conferred the Holy Confirmation for the boys from Cervaro, Pastenelle and Santa Lucia. He also met the catechists, operators of Caritas and liturgy animators, all the members of the pastoral councils and feast committees.

On Saturday 23 January, Bishop concluded his pastoral visit in the parish of Cervaro with the blessing of the Holy Altar in Santa Maria Maggiore, this year being it's bicentenary.

Fr. Ignacio Roderick expressed sincere gratitude to Fr. Francesco and Fr. Henry for their dedication and collaboration during this memorable event for the community of Cervaro and Pastenelle.

St. Thomas feast at Roccaasecca

Every year on 7 March, the feast day of Thomas Aquinas is celebrated in Roccasecca castle, his birthplace. He has been considered as one of the greatest and most influential intellects of the Catholic Church. His early studies of the Greek philosopher and his religious studies were what made him one of the most influential intellects of the Catholic Church. It was



from these studies that he wrote his most influential work called the Summa Theologica. Thomas Aquinas died on March 7, 1274. Nearly 100 years later his mortal remains were moved to Toulouse on January 28.

Although he is not the patron saint, in Roccasecca the devotion to him is very ancient and particularly felt. The celebrations in his honour are held on 7 March (anniversary of his death), the day in which a solemn Eucharistic celebration is held, followed by a procession from the Castello to Roccasecca Centre. As the statue passes, it is traditional for children to throw flowers at it.

In his honour, cultural events have been organized for many years, in which illustrious speakers pay homage to St. Thomas Aquinas, his thought and his works. This year the feast is celebrated respecting the norms of the Decrees of the Prime Minister. The parish priest, Don Xavier and Fr. Karun, mf, organized well the liturgical celebrations with *triduum* and holy adoration. The solemn Mass was presided over by Msgr. Gian Domenico.

Funeral of H. E. Msgr. Stephen Tje Phe

H. E. Msgr. Stephen The Phe, bishop of the diocese of Loikaw passed away, at the age of 65, on December 16, 2020. The Catholics in Kayah State, a stronghold of Catholicism in Myanmar, are mourning the death of an ethnic Kayah bishop. His funeral service was held at Christ the King Cathedral in Loikaw on December 18 with limited numbers in compliance with coronavirus guidelines from the health officials. Fr. Perpetual Profession



Continuation of the Ongoing Formation Corner....

According to this mode of evaluation the performance is judged basing on the average obtained from calculating the total score achieved and their percentage. For example, consider that the minimum score obtainable is 1 and the maximum is 5 (as in the table above). Each person in formation is different and the points one scores will vary accordingly. The scores obtained under each content variable is to be calculated and obtained its percentage. This percentage indicates the performance of the content. In this case the formative team should review the content of the project and improve the methods and instruments involved in its transmission. This way the evaluation renders the project more productive.

Conclusion

Project evaluation may seem time consuming and complicated. However, formators should take time and trouble to do it so as to evaluate the efficacy of their own formative project and to improve its prospects. It could be done by evaluating the contents, methods and instruments. In the present article are given two models of evaluation: descriptive and the scale models. The variables would be different according to the target group of the ongoing formation. An ongoing formation project for alcohol or internet addicts, sexual abusers etc. would certainly contain variables far more different from what is given in the models above. The coming issues would present formation projects for different target groups, as we conclude here the discussion on the general aspects of a project of formation.
